


Isaiah prophesizes Jesus

Main Scriptures: Isaiah 7:14, 9:1~7, 40:1~11, 52:13~53:12



The Prophet Isaiah lived about 2,700 years back. Isaiah received the Word from God and spoke to the people. Isaiah warned Israelites that they would be taken captives by Babylonians because they didn't obey* God. But then, he also prophesied that in time God would forgive them and bring them back to their land.



Isaiah prophesied the birth of Jesus.
"Behold, the virgin shall conceive* and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel."
'Immanuel' means 'God with us.'

It foretells of God being born as man,

which is Jesus.

Isaiah also prophesied that
Jesus Christ would die for our sins.
"But He was wounded for our transgressions,
He was bruised for our iniquities;
the chastisement for our peace was upon Him,
and by His stripes we are healed."
700 years after Isaiah's prophecy*,
Jesus came into the world and saved us from our sins.



^{*} Conceive: to get pregnant

^{*} Prophecy: A prediction of the future, made under divine inspiration.

Let's look up some Scriptures about Isaiah's prophecy of Jesus and the scriptures of prophecy that were fulfilled by Jesus.

700 years before Jesus came



"Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name (Isaiah 7:14)

He was wounded for our transgressions, He was Bruised for our iniquities (Isaiah 53:5)

He took our away, and died. Therefore He will not remember our (Isaiah 43:25)

The virgin gave birth to Jesus. (Matthew 1:21-25)

Jesus put on a crown of and was scourged. His wrists and feet were and His side was pierced with. (Isaiah 19:2,34)

Jesus came into this world, was crucified, and forgave our sins according to the Scriptures.

For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures. (1Corinthians 15:3-4)


Accuracy of Prophecies

And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself. (Luke 24:27)


Jesus quoted from the scriptures of the Old Testament when He expounded about Himself to the disciples From the birth to the death, Jesus' life has been prophesized in the Old Testament.

- 1, Jesus was born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2, Matthew 2:1)
- 2. Jesus was born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14. Matthew 1:18-23)
- 3. Jesus was born as a descendant of David (Jeremiah 23:5, Acts 13:22-23)
- 4. Jesus was betrayed by His acquaintance (Psalm 41:9, John 13:18, 19, 26)
- 5. Jesus was sold for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11: 12, Matthew 26: 14-16)
- 6. Jesus was crucified (Zechariah 12:10, John 19:16-18, 37)
- 7. They cast lots for Jesus' clothing (Psalm 22:18, Matthew 27:35)
- 8. Not one of Jesus' bone was broken (Psalm 34:20, John 19:31-36)
- 9. Jesus was buried in the rich man's tomb (Isaiah 53:9, Matthew 27:57-60)
- 10. Year, day, and time of Jesus' death (Daniel 9: 26-27, Matthew 27:45-50)
- 11. Jesus was resurrected in three days (Hosea 6: 2, Jonah 1: 17, Acts 10: 38-40)

What would be the probability for these many prophecies to come to pass on one person? Professor Peter Stoner calculated the probability of eight prophecies being accomplished by one person to be 1 out of 10 to the 33rd. Hence we can safely assume that the probability of 300 prophecies in the Old Testament regarding Jesus to come true is zero. This proves not only that Jesus is the Christ but also all the prophecies in the Bible are accurate and true.



The story of the lost son



Luke 15:11-24

Lesson 12 - Hezekiah the King of Judah


Hezekiah lived honest life before God and his earnest prayers earned him God's help.

Isaiah prophesized of Jesus' coming 700 years before Jesus came into this earth.
















