



The Good Samaritan

Luke 10:25-37



A certain lawyer stood up and tested Jesus.

“Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”

“What is written in the law? What is your reading of it?”

“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.”

“Yes, you have answered rightly do this and you will live.”

But a certain lawyer, wanting to justify himself, said to Jesus,

“and who is my neighbor?”

For all the law is fulfilled in one word,
even in this: "You shall love your
neighbor as yourself." (Galatians 5:14)

Then Jesus told of the story of a *Samaritan who helped a victim of a robber. A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell into the hands of thieves. They stripped him of his clothing, wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead. By chance, a certain priest came down that road, but when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. Likewise a Levite came by, but seeing him, he passed by on the other side. But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came and saw the man on the street. When he saw him, he had compassion for him, so he went over and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine. Then he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and paid *two denarii to have him taken care of him. He gave the innkeeper some money, saying,

"Take care of him, and whatever more you spend, I will repay you when I return."

Then Jesus said, "So which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the one who fell among the thieves?"

And he said! "He who showed mercy on him." So Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."

* two denarii: almost 24 days fee for staying

* Samaritan: The Jews ignored and thought negatively of the Samaritans because a gentile had come and lived together with them. Samaritan also hated Jews as enemy.
