Preaching the Gospel

1 Cor. 9:16, 2 Tim. 4:1-2



"For God so loved the world that He gave His only _____, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

"For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for _____ is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel." (1 Cor. 9:16)

The enormous love that we have received from God is not just for us, but for the whole world. Therefore, we, who have received that love already, ought to deliver that love to others.

The reasons why we must preach the gospel is: first of all, Jesus commanded us to do so in this world (Matt. 28:19-20). And on the day of judgement when the gospel is spread all around the world, it is for the wicked to be unable to make an excuse saying "surely we did not know this." Besides, as we are owed to the gospel, it is mandatory by all means. Woe is to us, if we don't preach the gospel (1 Cor. 9:16). Lastly, God has stored the glory like the brightness of the firmament for Christians who evangelize to others (Dan. 12:3). Then, what are we suppose to do in order for us to evangelize most efficiently?

First of all, we have to be separated from the sins of this world, and emit the fragrance of Christ and His light to families and friends around us. Only doing so, then their hearts can be moved.

Second, we have to keep up with studying the words of God so we can always be ready to answer questions when people ask about the hope that we have within ourselves.

Third, we have to pray constantly for the door of evangelism to be open to us. Don't give up after one or two days of praying, but pray without ceasing. God listens to all of those continuous prayers, and He will attain in the fullness of time (Luke 18).

And lastly, we ought to have passion for evangelizing. Jeremiah said "I will not make mention of Him, nor speak anymore in His name.

But His word was in my heart like a burning fire shut up in my bones; I was weary of holding it back, and I could not," and apostle Paul said "But none of these things move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God." Just like

them, we should deliver Jesus' love with burning passion.
