(John 19:30)



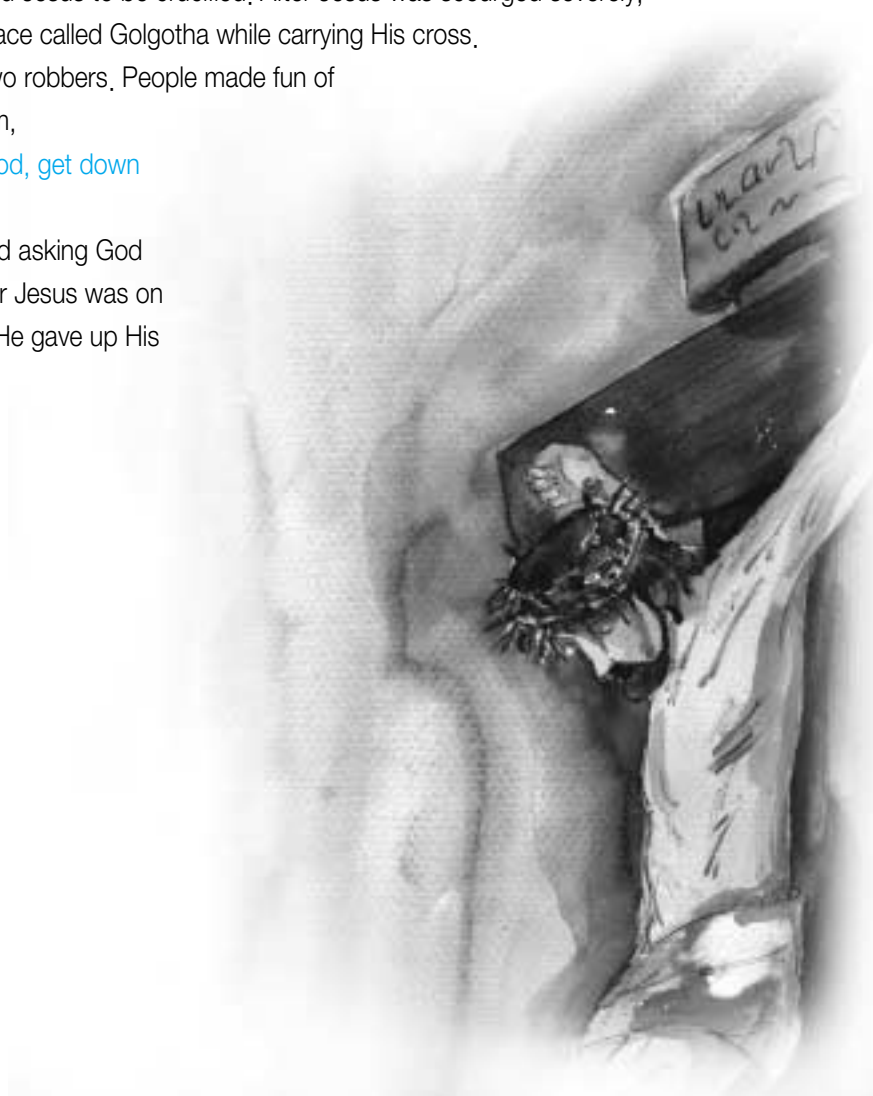
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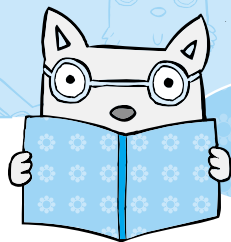
Pilate tried again to release Jesus but the Jews cried out all the more,

The Reason Why Jesus Came

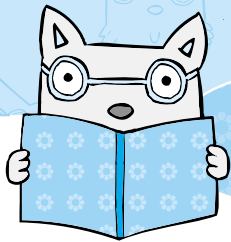
If Jesus did not come to this world, what would happen to us?
