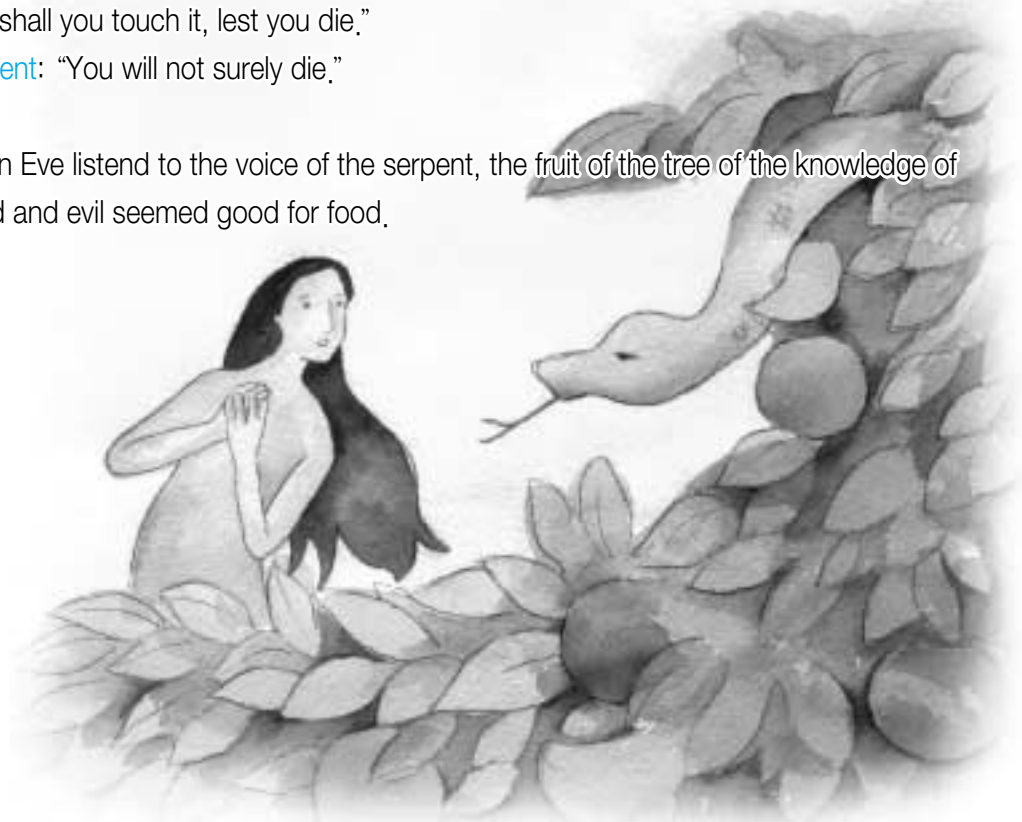
One day, the serpent, who was more cunning than any beast of the field, came to Eve.

**Serpent:** Has God indeed said, "You shall not eat of every tree of the garden?"

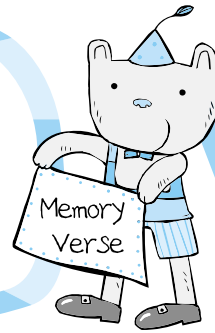

**For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous. (Romans 5:19)**
