Composition of Teaching materials !

Title, main passage and praises

Title and main passage are written, and the relevant praise is chosen. Teachers and students should read the main passage for several times and meditate on them.

Today's Lesson

Lessons were allocated by grade level by considering the entire curriculum of middle and high schools. When the curriculum is properly followed-through by teachers and students, the entire education and education by grade level are fulfilled. Teachers should determine the direction that doesn't deviate from the curriculum.

Opening mind

Before studying the main passage, preparing our hearts to receive the Word is important. For this purpose, materials that are interesting to students were selected to enhance their reception and understanding.

Meditating the words

More verses related to the main passage are included for more profound meditation. Teachers and students can have closer fellowship with God through the meditation.

Changing Your Thoughts

Our thoughts and plans are adjusted to the evident will of God, and the connection between God's word and our lives is understood through the process. Teachers should convey God's will and message to the students.

Understand the lesson

Lesson is outlined so that the main scripture is understood, every content is discussed, and the lesson is not crammed nor lectured. Teachers and students should actively and dynamically participate and collaborate together so the lesson can be learned effectively.

Engraving the lesson in your mind

Memorizing the verses is an important habit to get used to in our spiritual life. It is also essential for our spiritual growth. Verse within the main passage that's essential for us inscribe in our hearts is selected for the memorization verse. English version is obtained from NKJV.

Applying the Words to the Life

Through this section, we are convicted to apply the word in our lives, and also reflect back on and evaluate on our last week's conviction.

Praying to Follow the Words

Through this section, we ask God to help us to live according to our conviction after learning the Bible. Our week's spiritual life is strengthened and empowered through writing, reading and praying the content of our prayers.

Appendix

Various materials that correspond to the main passage are selected and included to aid students' spiritual lives and supplement their spiritual growth.

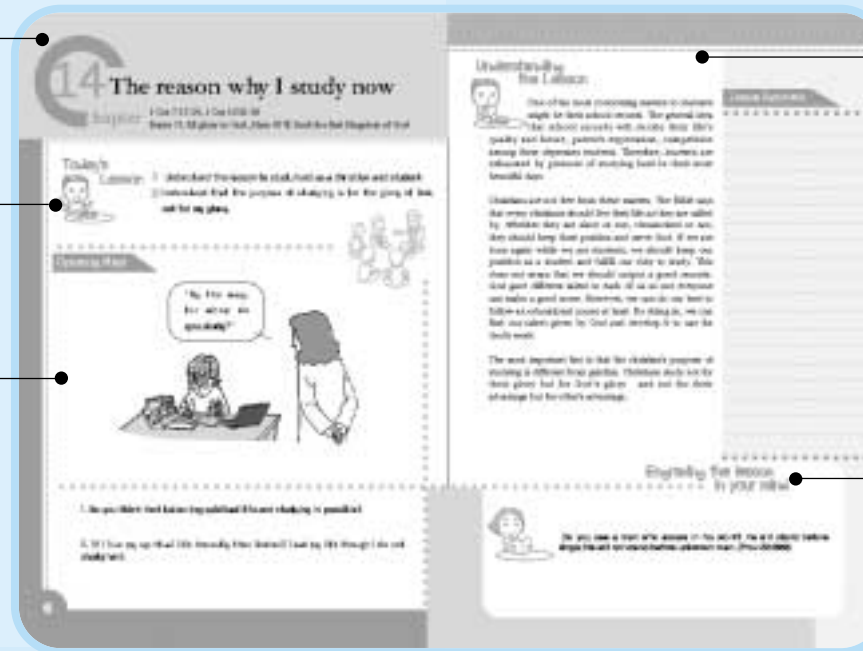

Understanding the Lesson



One of the most concerning matters to students might be their school records. The general idea that school records will decide their life's quality and future, parent's expectation, competition among them depresses students. Therefore, students are exhausted by pressure of studying hard in their most beautiful days.

Christians are not free from these matters. The Bible says that every Christians should live their life as they are called by. Whether they are slave or not, circumcised or not, they should keep their position and serve God. If we are born again while we are students, we should keep our position as a student and fulfill our duty to study. This does not mean that we should output a good records. God gave different talent to each of us so not everyone can make a good score. However, we can do our best to follow an educational course at least. By doing so, we can find our talent given by God and develop it to use for God's work.

The most important fact is that the christian's purpose of studying is different from gentiles. Christians study not for their glory but for God's glory and not for their advantage but for other's advantage.

The reason that I could graduate from Seoul National University, which is the top school in Korea, with the best school record is literally from the grace of God. I could have this result by the grace of God's knowledge and wisdom. From now on, I will live as a theologian and develop the grace on the study. I could have the grace on the study given to me because I focused on study with the clear purpose, memorized the Bible verses and prayed according to God's will. My parent have trained me to pray and live a spiritual life according to the Bible since I was very young. There is no other secret of success. Only praying and meditations are the secret. You might think that this is too simple answer, but I have studied and prayed hard accordingly since I was young. I am keeping this life even now. Proverb 1:7 says

"The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline."

I held this verse. Just before entering university, I was beaten by my mother harshly. My friends saw a bruise on my body and asked why my mother beats me so much even if you make a good school records. They bullied me that my mother is a stepmother. But the reason that I was beaten was simple. It was because I did not live as a christian, according to God's word. Our home had a great principle since we believed in God.

"Do not eat unless you pray. Do not study unless you read the Bible."

This sounds weird but I was trained like that. My mother trained me to pray in a certain time of the day, and she always said I do not need to study unless I read certain chapters a day.

"You are a child of God, and priest like a King. You did not born to live for you. You are a christian living for the glory of God. Christian live for the glory of God whenever they eat, drink or do anything else. Therefore do not think about eat some food before praying which means breathing of christians. Hard working and entering prestigious university is important, yet all should be done for the glory of God. Nothing is more important than the glory of God. The Bible is the food for spirit. Therefore, there is no need to study if you do not read the Bible in order to save some time to study."

God's word was the law of my life. Whenever I behaved wrongly in the light of the Word, I get whipped on the calf without an exception. But I appreciate my mother although I get whipped so much. I understood the life of Christian in depth, as I get a bruise on my calf.
