Holiness

2Cor6:14-18, John3:3



And you shall be holy to Me, for I the LORD am holy, and have separated you from the peoples, that you should be Mine. (Leviticus 20:26)

Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth. As You sent Me into the world, I also have sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also may be sanctified by the truth. (John 17:17-19)

Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. (2 Corinthians 7:1)

God saved us from our sins through the offering of the body of Jesus and adopted us as His holy children. Not only that, He separated us from this world and hopes to live with us in heaven, His holy kingdom (Hebrews 10:10).

First of all, just like God told the Israelites “you should be holy just as I am holy” when he delivered them out of Egypt, God separated us from this sinful world and said “Do not touch what is unclean” (2 Corinthians 6:17). In addition, God told us to cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God (2 Corinthians 7:1). Even though we lived among this sinful world, following our own desires before we got saved, we must submit to God’s word and lead a holy life now that we are born again. Our hearts and conduct should be holy and clear of guilt, worthy of children of God. However, we are in unstable state that we can fall into sin at anytime before Jesus’ return. Our spirits become defiled by a false doctrine, our souls become defiled by sinful desires, and our bodies become defiled by our wrongdoings. Therefore we have to protect ourselves from worldly temptations and deceits in order to keep our spirit, soul, and body flawless until we stand before God (1 Thessalonians 5:23). In order to do that, we must dwell in fellowship. It is within this fellowship where the word of God is abundantly provided. Just like washing of water, our sins wash away when we listen to the word and meditate on it (Ephesians 5:26). Also, our transgressions are revealed and cleansed within the fellowship.

Next, we have to pray continuously. It is very important that you look back on yourselves through prayer and correct your misbehaviors. This world becomes more wicked as the second coming of Jesus approaches nearer. When Jesus comes back, the wicked and the righteous will be revealed clearly. We must be separated through our holy conduct so that we can welcome Jesus’ return with joyful heart (Revelations 22:10-11).
